I. <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>



TO SWITCH ON:

- Open the lamp
- Switch on the lamp, after 2 minutes warm-up the lamp reaches its complete light output.
- The lamp must burn minimum 2 minutes before switching off.

TO SWITCH OFF:

• The lamp may be switched off after it has been burning for at least 2 minutes.

GUIDELINES

After switching on the lamp it has to stay switched on for at least 2 minutes! After switching off the lamp you may switch it on again after 2 minutes. Neglecting these guidelines results in reducing the life endurance of the lamp tube. When the voltage of the battery is too low, the lamp switches off automatically. Switch off the lamp and charge the battery of the PLU with the Teklite battery charger.

II. CHARGING THE BATTERY OF THE PLU 2

Charge the battery of the Teklite PLU 2 with the Charger Module 12/12 (Cat. No. 16331), the 24/12 (Cat. No. 16332) or 12/230V (Cat. No. 15683).

- Connect the charger module correctly to the 12V supply.
- Before connecting the plug of the battery charger on the PLU switch off the charge module and the battery charger.
- Connect the plug of the battery charger into the socket on top of the housing.
- Switch on the charger module, the red LED burns.

When the battery is fully charged the green LED burns.

• Before taking it into use, first switch off the battery charger and unplug the socket of the PLU.

The PLU 2 is equipped with a maintenance-free, rechargeable, lead-acid battery which is appropriate for constant charging and regular use. This battery is relatively simple in use and simple to charge. The life endurance of the battery depends on a correct charging. The Teklite battery chargers have been specifically designed for the built-in battery. They are protected against overcharging of the built-in battery and against deep discharge of the vehicle battery. For stand-by applications they automatically change to a floating trickle charge keeping the battery in perfect condition with no danger of overcharging.

The following points guarantee a long life endurance of the battery:

- Charge the battery within the following ambient temperatures : $0^{\circ}C 40^{\circ}C$
- When the PLU hasn't been used for a long time, it has to be connected regularly to the charging module and this for a maximum period of 3 months between 2 charges.
- Charge the battery always fully (green LED)
- It is not necessary to discharge the battery completely before recharging.

GUIDELINES

If after switching on the battery charger the red LED doesn't burn, even if the voltage of the charger module is connected and the plug of the battery charger of the PLU is connected, the fuse may be damaged. Disconnect the charger of the feeder, unscrew the fuse cap and change the fuse.

ATTENTION

Change the fuse only after having checked the cause and having repaired it. Replace the fuse only by the same type and the same value and it may not be overbridged in any other way.

III. GUIDELINES

In exceptional cases, when there is no Teklite battery charger available, the PLU battery may be charged with a conventional battery charger, if the following points are respected:

- The used battery charger must have the possibility to limit the charging current, namely with an adjustable charging current (Ampère).
- The battery charger must be appropriate to charge 12V batteries.
- For the connection, you have to use the Teklite LV10 plug (Cat. No. 15465)

Working Method

- Switch off the battery charger and connect the plug on the PLU battery.
- Connect the red cable of the charger on the positive and the black cable on the negative ground.
- The maximum permitted charging current may not exceed 2,3 A.
- After 5 hours charging switch off the battery charger and disconnect from the PLU.

ATTENTION

A too high charging current, namely higher than the maximum permitted 2,3 A or not respecting the maximum charging current time of 5 hours when conventional battery chargers are used, can lead to the explosion of the battery.

GUIDELINE

When using another battery charger than the recommended Teklite battery charger, the Teklite charger module 12/12V(Cat. No. 16331), 24/12V(Cat. No. 16332) or 12/230V (Cat. No. 15683), the guarantee of the PLU falls away.




